




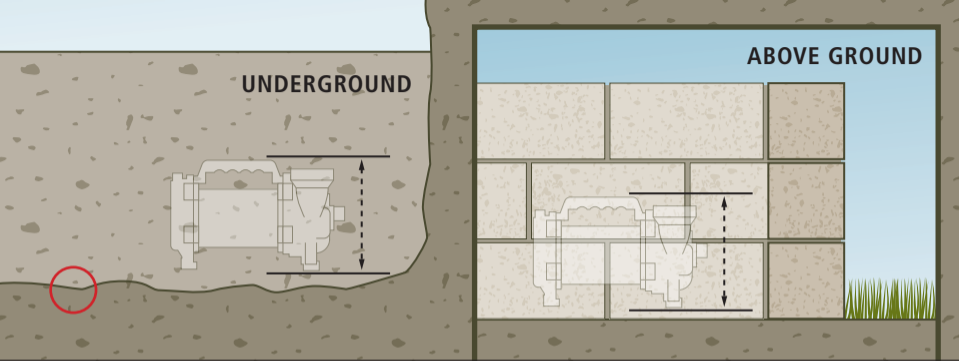

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HOW TO INSTALL **FOUNTAINS**

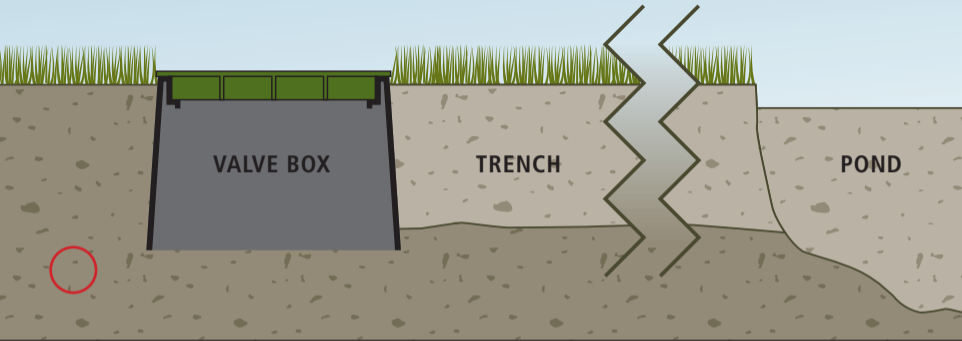
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Dig a hole for the basin of the pond. The hole needs to be deep enough to submerge the pump in water.

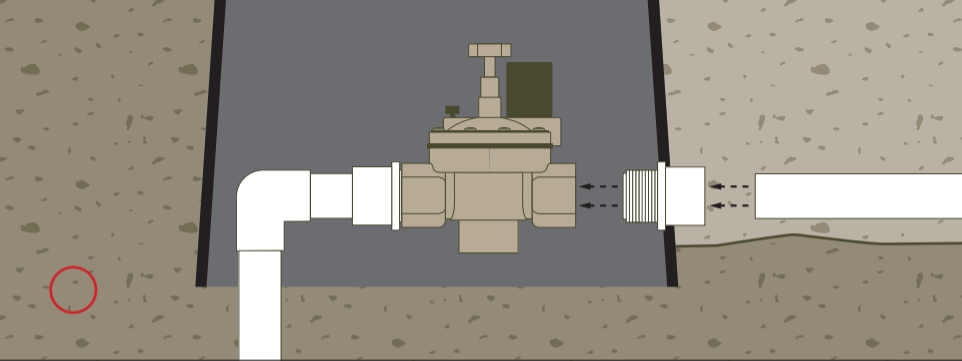
If an above-ground pond is built, build the desired basin for the pond (a plastic tub, cinder blocks, sand bags, etc. may be used for the wall). Skip steps 2-4.





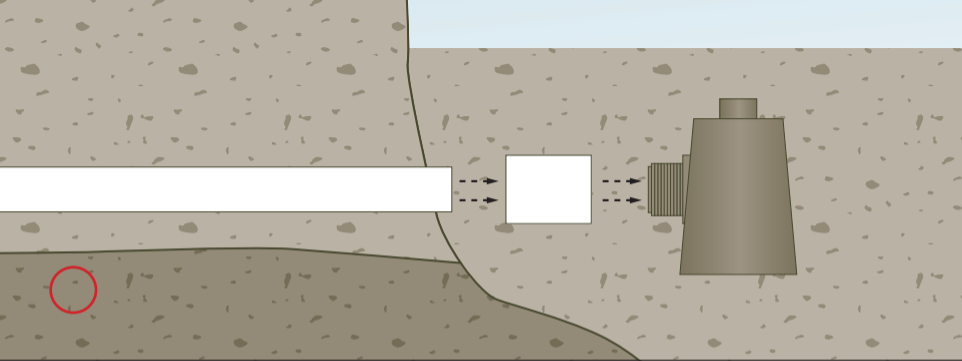
Dig a trench for your sprinkler line to run from the valve box to the pond.

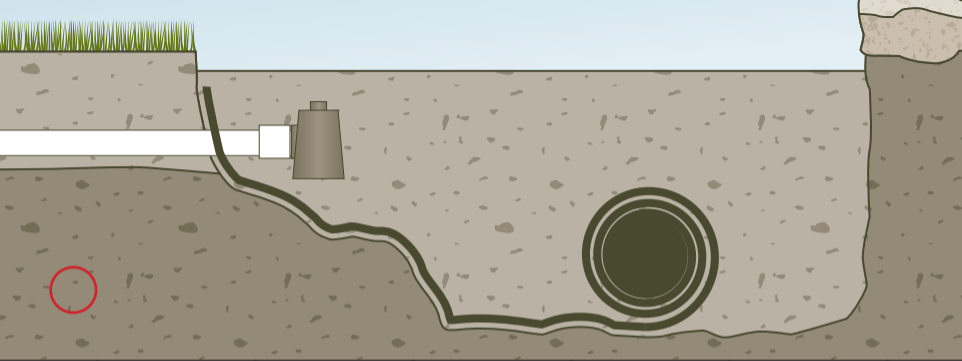
Connect the PVC pipe into the valve.

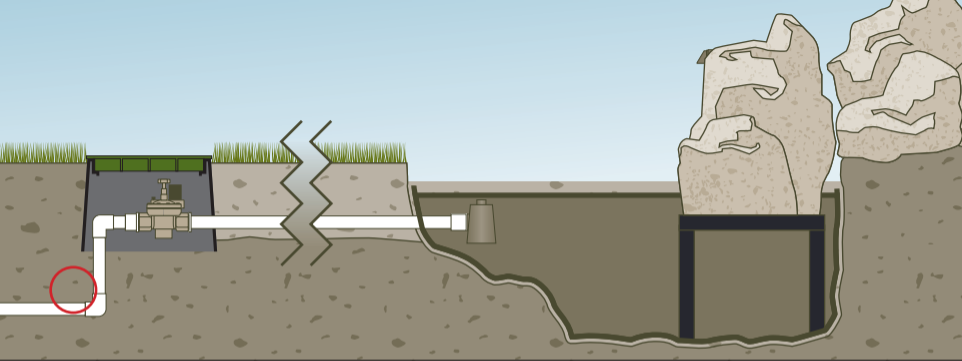
Connect the float valve with a female adapter to the PVC pipe.

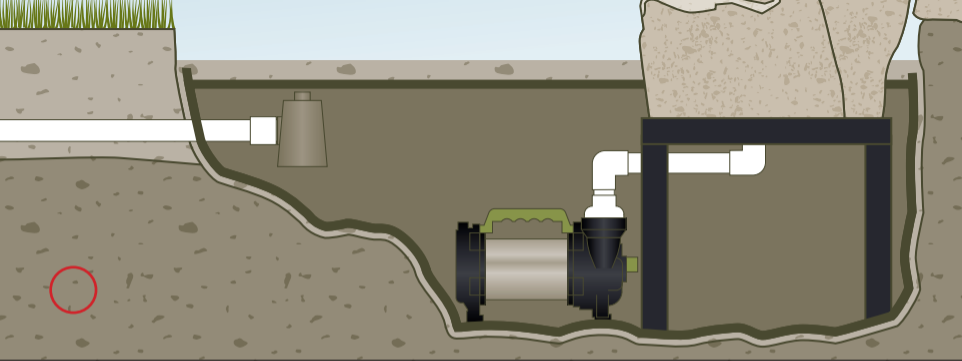
Lay the pond liner.

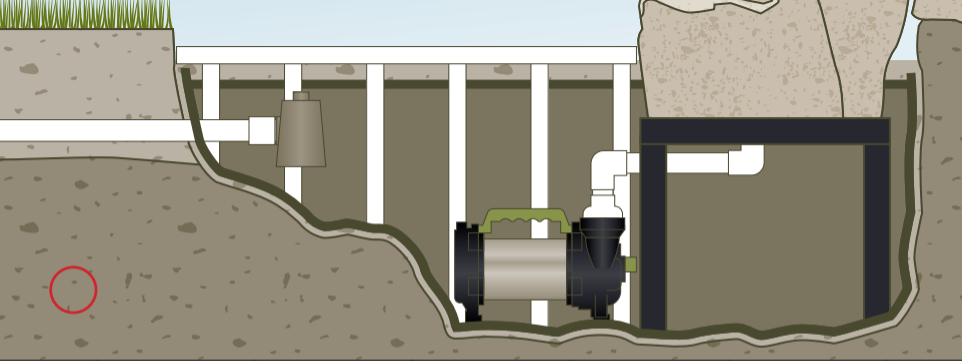
Set the rock.

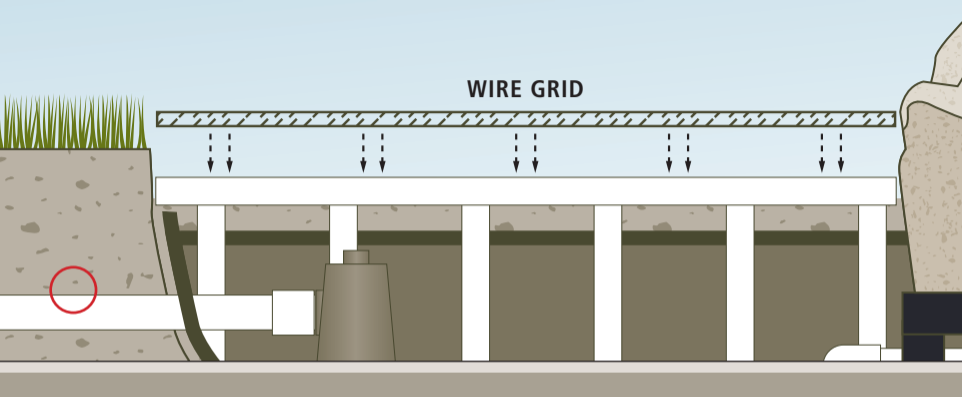
Connect the pump to the PVC system through the rock.

Install a support system.

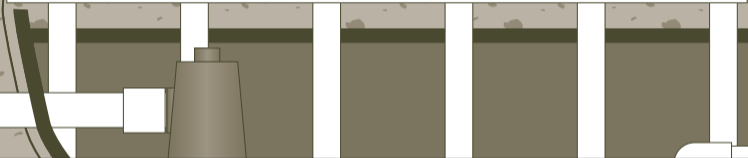
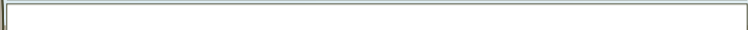
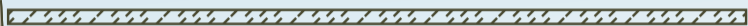

to support system.

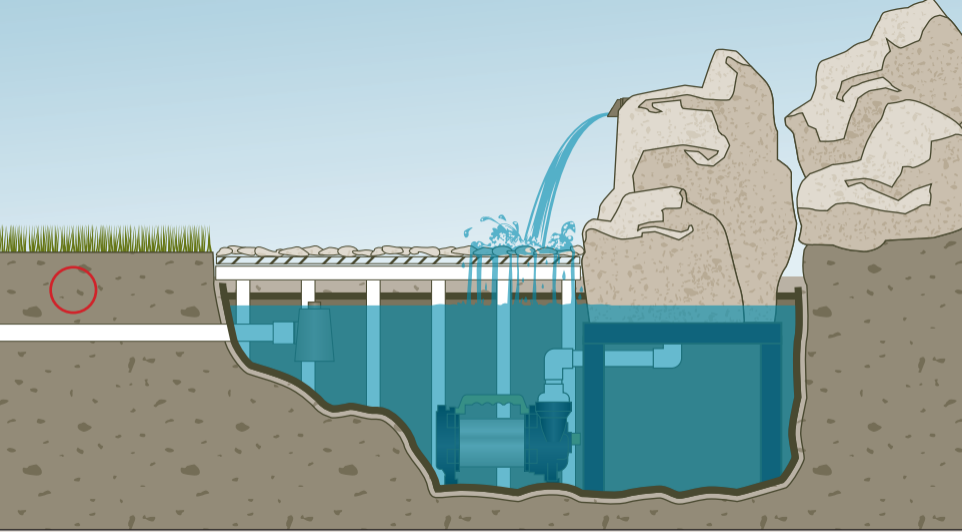
